



CDST Membership Fee Schedule

USS Annual Registration Fee

All CDST members must join USS (USA Swimming) in order to practice with the team. The annual USS registration fee includes the required liability insurance to attend all USS sanctioned swim meets. It must be completely paid before a swimmer can attend to practice in our team or participate in a meet. The current annual membership fee is **\$60.00**.

CDST Annual Registration Fee

A \$35 annual registration fee covers a CDST swimmer's practices in all events and training associated with CDST.

Sibling Discount

Families with two or more swimmers in the club will receive 20% sibling discount for each additional swimmer. The first swimmer in a family will pay dues as listed above and the discount will apply to only the additional sibling swimmers in the family thereafter.

Billing Policy

California Dolphin Swim Team is a year-round team requiring annual commitment from its members with an obligation for 12 months of dues. It is for this reason we are able to operate at the above monthly dues without requiring additional fund-raising commitments from our members. The dues above barely cover the costs of our high-quality coaching and other associated swim activities necessary to support a premier, highly competitive, year-round swim team.

A USS swim team billing calendar typically runs from Sept 1 to August 31. The 12-month dues are required for each swimmer, and the dues will not be prorated based on attendance. The dues specified in the fee schedule above, are billed to our swimmer parents through our website service provider TeamUnify's billing systems.

The initial payment for joining our team or the 1st payment in September for renewing annual team membership is the sum of the first month and the last month's dues:

- For new swimmers with the 1st scheduled regular practice starts on or after the 15th, their 1st month due is only half of the monthly regular fee above.
- The last month (August) due shall be paid with the initial or the 1st payment.
- The payment should be made out to CDST.

Enrollment must be complete with all fees/dues paid, prior to beginning regular practices.

New Swimmers may have one FREE practice to evaluate the program.

Withdrawal Policy: Notification of withdrawal from the team must be submitted in advance in writing, which must arrive to the team office by the 15th of the month prior to the effective date next month. Any notification received after the 15th of the month will result in the obligation of the due for that following month.

Leave of Absence (LOA) (i.e., Summer vacation, High School Swimming, Water Polo, other sports or commitments): If a swimmer decides to take a leave of absence for a period of less than three months (or 92 days), they will be responsible for paying half dues for the months missed in order to keep the spot on the team **before** leaving. If a swimmer wants to return after a more than three month absence or without advanced payment, s/he will be considered a new swimmer member, and therefore subject to all first-time registration fees.

Medical LOA: When a swimmer is absent for one or more calendar months, the prorated dues on LOA can be waived for any illness or injury if a required proof from a physician in writing is provided.

Travel Trips: It is the responsibility of parents to provide for the cost of transportation, lodging and meals when their swimmers travel out-of-town for any swim meets. Any swimmer whose dues are delinquent will NOT be permitted to participate in team travel trips.
